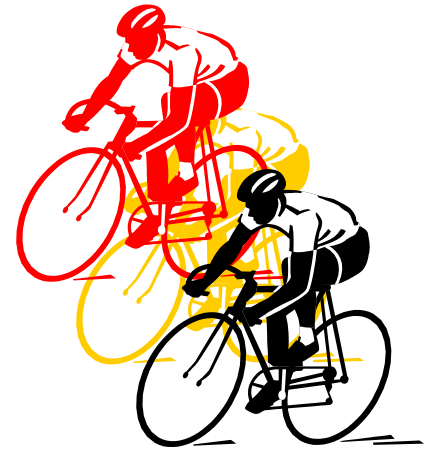

A note regarding prizes:

Chesterfield Coureurs strive to ensure that our promotion is superbly organised and a fitting tribute to Harry Cook. However we feel that this year we came up short of this expectation, and for that we apologise for the following errors which we hope we have (or will) rectify:

1. James Hill was not initially listed as a junior, but as he turned 18 during the current calendar year he most *definitely is* a junior. Fortunately this was pointed out before the prizes were given out. Well done on the course record James!

2. Sarah Bell was initially given 5th placing in the ladies competition but her time was 1 minute out. Therefore she was, in fact, the second placed lady. To rectify this, the ladies (Helen, Iona and Sandra) originally awarded prizes for 2nd – 4th will **keep** these prizes and Sarah will be given a prize which reflects her second place. Well done to Sarah on her brilliant time, and her course record, and apologies to Iona who thought she had held the course record for a while.

One of the reasons for the mistakes was because we were trying to get the prizes awarded as quickly as possible as many riders were anxious to get to Matlock for the race on Bank Road. Not only did this create some errors, but also the magnificent achievements by some of the riders were not given the attention and credit they deserved. I plan to contact Chris Mottram to see whether the race on Bank Road can be put back by half an hour next year to ease the congestion, but in the meantime Chesterfield Coureurs offer their sincere congratulations to:
